Policy Guidance on Signs and Flags

February 5, 2022

In compliance with the Overland Cove HOA Covenants and Restrictions

The Hoa Board has adopted the following guidance for homeowners regarding signs and flags.

Signs and Flags are permitted under the following circumstances:

One welcome board sign placed on resident's front porch.

One flag attached to a resident's fence or wall. (American/School/Seasonal)

Free Standing Flag Poles are Prohibited

Small Security Company sign in front or rear shrub beds.

One small garden flag in front or rear shrub beds that meet one of the

following criteria: (American/School/Welcome/Seasonal)

One For Sale or For Rent sign can only be displayed in front window.

All other signs are prohibited to include political signs of any nature.

If an owner has any questions about the permissibility of a flag or sign they must submit a request to the HOA Architectural Committee

through the HOA's management company for approval.

Signs or flags in violation of this policy will be removed by the owner

within three days after notification by the HOA's management company.

Failure to comply will result in a \$100 fine being assess to the

owner's account.
