Overland Cove HOA Policy for Vacation or Short Term Rentals August 9, 2022

Pursuant to Article VI Section 1 General, Section 2 (Residential Use) and Section 5 (Leasing) of the Overland Cove HOA Covenants and Restrictions the Board has adopted the following policy regarding licensing property for transient purposes.

- Vacation or short-term (less than 1 year) rentals are not permitted.
 Licensing a property or a portion of a property for vacation rentals and other transient use is not permitted. Overland Cove is Zoned R2 Residential and Short-term or Airbnb rentals are prohibited by the city of Huntsville.
- 2. The Board and their Management Agent will regularly review listings of properties on rental business sites such as Airbnb, Vrbo and others to determine if owners have their property or a portion of their property listed for vacation rentals or other transient use short term rentals.
- 3. In the event that an owner is found to have listed their property or a portion of their property they will be notified that they have 7 days to delist their property and to cease licensing for transient renting for non-residential business purposes. short term leases.
 - 1. After the notification, if the owner fails to do delist in 7 days a fine of \$2,500 every 30 days will be levied against their account beginning on the 8th day after notification until the property is delisted.
 - 2. Repeat offenders of this policy will lose all common area access and privileges.
